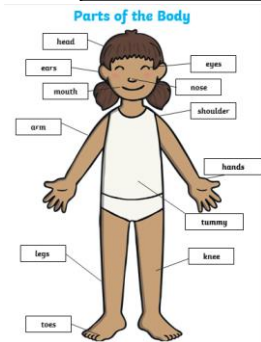
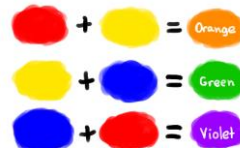


Summer
