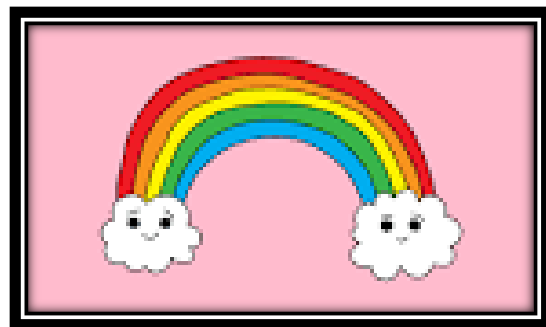


Monday 6th April
