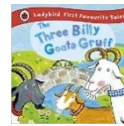
WHAT ARE WE DOING IN NURSERY THIS WEEK?

Ask us questions about the new stories we are reading!

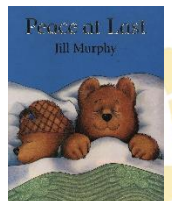
- Continuing to explore patterns. We are exploring and making patterns using natural objects.
