- Learning about the rules and routines in Nursery.

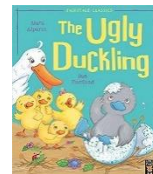
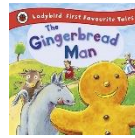


- **We are continuing to explore our new story sack stories!**
