

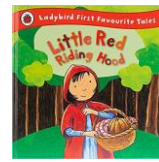
# WREN'S NEST PRIMARY SCHOOL

## WHAT ARE WE DOING IN NURSERY THIS WEEK?

- Learning about the rules and routines for the Foundation Stage.

- Exploring Advent as we begin our countdown to Christmas Day on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> December! We will be making Christingles to help represent the symbolic image of advent. It helps us remember *Christingle* is a joyful celebration that brings people together to shine the light and spread a message of hope.
