

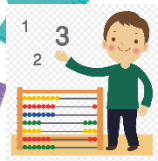
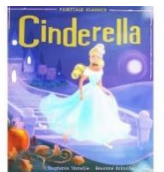
# WREN'S NEST PRIMARY SCHOOL
