



Trip money going cashless at Wren's Nest!

Dear Parents,

From Monday 2nd September, we are delighted to inform you that we have recently signed up to your child's £15 voluntary trip payment via our new on-line system with **SchoolMoney**. This means that you will now have the facility to make payments for your child's trip money on-line with your debit or credit card.

Over the last 6 months, many parents have been using our on-line payment for their child's school meals and it has been a great success.

This new payment system will benefit both us as a school and you as a parent. Not only will you be able to pay for your child's voluntary trip contribution from the comfort of your own home but you will also be able to access your account at any time to see what the balance is. You may also use this system to pay the money in instalments as well as knowing the payment system is secure and safe.

You won't need to sign up to this system as this is done automatically through the school and as long as you have provided us with up to date contact details we will send you a password within the next few days. This password will give you access to your **SchoolMoney** account where you can pay for your child's trip contribution and don't worry if you haven't got a debit or credit card, there is also a facility for you to pay via Pay Point using a pre-printed 'barcode' at various locations:

Chatthas & Sons - 83 Wrens Nest Road

McColls - 158 Old Park Road

Kings of Premiers - 41-42 Beech Green

If you would like to make payment via Pay Point please pop into the office and ask for further details.

To log into **SchoolMoney**, visit the website **www.eduspot.co.uk** and click on the sign in button in the top right hand corner. In the drop down, select the **SchoolMoney Parent Login** option and this will send you through to a page where you need to enter your mobile number, email address, the password we have sent to you, and your child's first name.

If for any reason you are struggling to log in, it may be because the details we have are incorrect, so pop into the school reception and they will be able to help you. Please let us know immediately if either your mobile number or email address changes.

We appreciate your co-operation in the early stages of rolling this system out to you and we will still be able to accept cash in the first 2 weeks of the system going live for your child. It is hoped that in the future we will be adding uniform money too.
