- If there are any concerns, can parents be contacted directly on the day of concern or issue. Not all parents can do drops-off and pick-ups so sometimes information cannot always be shared promptly.
- I think you doing a great job. I love the Christmas Market and events for the school community and would support any extras that can be done to raise funds for the school.
- Wren's Nest has a variety of activities in school to attract their pupils and that allows them to be in school more and not on social media. This is a good advantage for any parent to feel safe with their children in school. School also calls me if something happens to make parents aware of the situation so we can be involved when necessary. I will recommend Wren's Nest to anyone.
- I feel more can be done with assisting parents with toilet training and coming out of nappies and into pants. I understand it is hard with staffing levels.
