- Not necessarily for future development but acknowledgement of the fantastic work the teachers are doing in Nursery and Time for Twos. I was very hesitant sending my children to nursery as unfortunately you hear quite a lot of horror stories, but I have been so happy with both of the children's experiences. They both settled well very quickly, the children lost their father last year and both teachers Miss Lavender and Miss Ward have been supporting the children beautifully in class when they speak about their father especially around Valentine's Day and most recently Mother's Day when they were talking about families. They do a range of different activities and always come home smiling excited to tell me what they've done that day, Miss Lavender and Miss Wood have been particularly helpful with issues that have arisen at home with C, with helpful suggestions and advice on who to contact if I need further support. Miss Ward and the other teachers that help with Time for Twos are always so warm and welcoming, always there to lend a listening ear, I'm so grateful to them for providing such exceptional care and support.
- I've previously discussed in parents' evening that my doctor is waiting for report on my child because my GP is exploring the fact my child might have autism issues. I'm still waiting for response of teachers which I'm consistently approaching them about subject and still received nothing.
- My son is in early years education. He's spent Time for Twos and Nursery at this school, and it's brought out the best in him. Highly recommend the school because all needs are met and any worries have been addressed.
