

Phonics at Wren's Nest Primary School

Phonics teaching at Wren's Nest Primary School is key to everyday learning. Reading is a skill that is needed to meet the demands of everyday life. Phonics teaches children to read accurately and fluently with good comprehension. They learn to form each letter correctly, spell words accurately and compose their ideas step-by-step. Phonics instruction teaches children how to decode letters into their respective sounds, a skill that is essential for them to read unfamiliar words by themselves. Most words are in fact unfamiliar to early readers in print, even if they have spoken knowledge of the word. At Wren's Nest we want to give our children a real life understanding of reading. Teaching young children to read helps them develop their

Content and Sequencing

- ✓ T42s/Nursery recognise sounds in the environment. Learn poems and rhymes.
- ✓ Preschool Learn friezes and orally blend. Learn poems and rhymes and play listening games with Fred talk.
- Reception Read single letter set 1 sounds, blend sounds into words orally, blend sounds to read words; read short Ditty stories, read Red story books, read Green story books and read some Set 2 sounds. Learn poems and rhymes and play listening games with Fred talk.
- Year 1 Read set 2 and set 3 sounds. Read Purple, Pink, Orange, Yellow and Blue story books. Learn poems and rhymes.
- Year 2 Read set 2 and 3 sounds. Read Blue and Grey story books with increasing fluency and comprehension. Access RWI Spelling Programme. Learn poems and rhymes.
- ✓ Years 3 6 Fresh Start. Fresh Start is a phonics intervention for older children who have not made the expected progress in reading. Children are assessed and grouped according to their phonic knowledge, taught the 44 basic sounds, shown how to blend phonemes, and finally taken through more advanced skills such as spelling and writing.

Phonics at Wren's Nest is tailored to the needs of the children. The children remain on the RML Phonics programme until they can read fluently. They access the RML Get Writing Scheme alongside this. They then move on to the Literacy and Language programme which follows on from RML Phonics/Get Writing.
