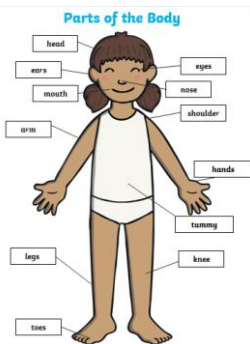
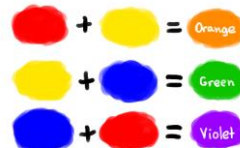


Spring

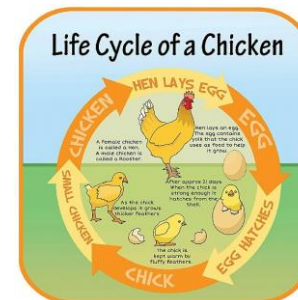
