- Continuing to mark-make and practise how to write our name and form our letters correctly, using a range of mark-making tools.

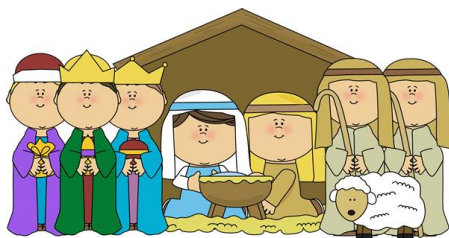


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WHAT ARE WE DOING IN RECEPTION THIS WEEK?
