WHAT ARE WE DOING IN RECEPTION THIS WEEK?

- Continuing to learn the rules and routines for the Foundation Stage.



- Continuing to develop our listening and attention skills to explore our new sounds, 'm, a, s, d, t, i, n, p, g, o, c, k, u, b, f, e, l, h, r, j, v, y, w, sh and ch' in our phonics groups. Ask us about the new sounds we are learning!



- Exploring numbers 0-20 to recognise, count out, write, subitise and order numbers correctly and confidently. Ask us about the numbers we have been exploring this week!



- Continuing to mark-make and practise how to write our name and form our letters correctly, using a range of mark-making tools.



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WHAT ARE WE DOING IN RECEPTION THIS WEEK?

- Exploring the season of winter, looking closely at the changes it brings. We are looking at changes in the **weather, temperature** and changes in **trees and plants** outside. **What changes can you see on your way to school.**



- Exploring the winter story, 'One Snowy Night' by Nick Butterworth to find out more about Percy the Park Keeper. **Ask us about what we have been reading!**
