WHAT ARE WE DOING IN RECEPTION THIS WEEK?

- Continuing to learn the rules and routines for the Foundation Stage.



- Continuing to develop our listening and attention skills to explore our new sounds, 'm, a, s, d, t, i, n, p, g, o, c, k, u, b, f, e, l, h, r, j, v, y, w, sh and ch' in our phonics groups. Ask us about the new sounds we are learning!



- Exploring numbers 0-20 to recognise, count out, write, subitise and order numbers correctly and confidently. Ask us about the numbers we have been exploring this week!



- Continuing to mark-make and practise how to write our name and form our letters correctly, using a range of mark-making tools.



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WHAT ARE WE DOING IN RECEPTION THIS WEEK?

- Exploring the festival of 'Chinese New Year' to find out about the different customs and traditions that Chinese people have during this special time.
- Trying very hard to use chopsticks this week! We are using different chopsticks and tweezers to pick up Chinese rice and beads. **Ask us how well we used our chopsticks!**
- Taking part in a Chinese food tasting session as we explore China and the different food that is eaten to celebrate Chinese New Year. **Ask us about our fortune cookies!**
