We are starting to explore Set 2 sounds, 'ay' and 'ee'. We are beginning to explore 'ditty sheets' and Red Books. Ask us about the new sounds we are learning!



- Exploring numbers 0-20 to recognise, count out, write, subitise and order numbers correctly and confidently. Ask us about the numbers we have been exploring this week!



- Continuing to mark-make and practise how to write our name and form our letters correctly, using a range of mark-making tools.



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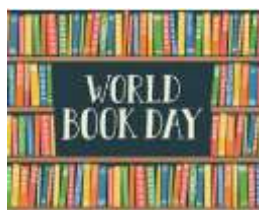
- Exploring 'Saint David's Day' and special traditions that come with it. Ask us about what we have been learning!
