- Continuing to learn the rules and routines for the Foundation Stage.



- Continuing to develop our listening and attention skills to explore our new sounds, 'm, a, s, d, t, i, n, p, g, o, c, k, u, b, f, e, l, h, r, j, v, y, w, sh and ch' in our phonics groups. We are starting to explore Set 2 sounds, 'ay' and 'ee'. We are beginning to explore 'ditty sheets' and Red Books. Ask us about the new sounds we are learning!



- Exploring numbers 0-20 to recognise, count out, write, subitise and order numbers correctly and confidently. Ask us about the numbers we have been exploring this week!



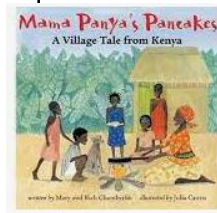
- Continuing to mark-make and practise how to write our name and form our letters correctly, using a range of mark-making tools.
