The school has continued to work towards meeting the Gold Award criteria (when open) even though this was not awarded this year due to COVID 19. As a school, we wanted to continue to maintain a high standard of Sports teaching and experiences whenever possible due to such inactivity and isolation during the National Lockdown periods. We will continue to strive for this award as we enter the academic year 2021/22.

For 2021/22, we will continue to receive a grant of £19,500 Sports Premium money. Planned expenditure is similar to last year (2020/21) with some increased costs to cover our sporting competition expenses. We are hoping to build upon the achievements of last year (despite COVID 19) and continue to be increasingly successful in sporting competitions. Capacity in school to deliver high quality PE continues to grow as we now have a dedicated member of the Senior Leadership Team who will support the development of PE and Healthy Living teaching and learning at Wren's Nest. This is in addition to, two members of staff who are able to deliver a specialist PE role and support across the school. The impact of this increased expertise is sustainable within our staffing budget.
