Literacy

As part of the Ruth Miskin Phonics programme, children will be exploring initial letter sounds as they learn Set 1 'Speed Sounds'. Literacy will also include writing Set 1 sounds and simple words, and sharing our favourite stories.

Maths

Children will continue to develop understanding of numerals to 20 through counting, ordering, recording, subitising and begin exploring basic addition.
