



Wren's Nest KS1 SEND Provision

Sunflowers

To be read alongside all other school policies.

Sunflowers is a small group provision for children in Key Stage 1 with cognition and learning needs. Children within Sunflowers may have a moderate and/or specific learning difficulty which requires a tailored curriculum to meet their individual needs. Children may also have further needs including Speech and language difficulties, social and emotional and mental health needs and/or physical disabilities.

The provision is led by an experienced Teacher and supported by a full time Teaching Assistant. The Sunflowers provision supports some of our most vulnerable children in having their needs met on a small group basis.

Sunflowers supports up to 15 Key Stage 1 children who have a range of needs. Children attend Sunflowers daily, from 8:40am to 12:00pm. During this time, they access Phonics and Numeracy sessions. Sunflowers has a bespoke curriculum which is tailored to meet the needs of the children. All children who access Sunflowers re-join their peers in their mainstream class from lunchtime and continue to access the wider curriculum lessons in the afternoon with an appropriate level of support.

The children within Sunflowers make good personal progress with their literacy and numeracy skills.

This key principle is at the heart of the provision we offer at Wren's Nest within Sunflowers is allowing all children to be successful, whatever their barriers are to learning.
