Hello, so it's time to move into Year 2.

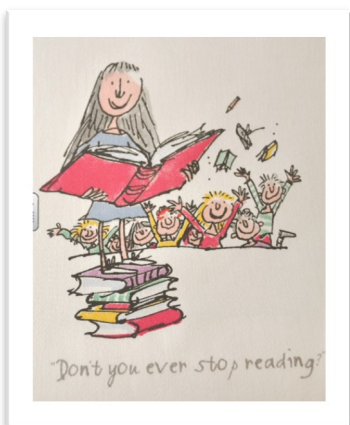


We are looking forward to the new school year.

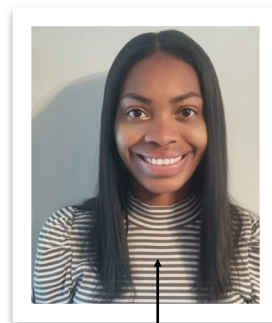

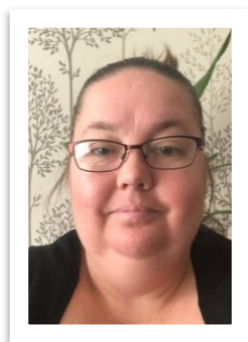

Information for grown ups.
