## Spring



- Spring is the season between winter and summer.
- The weather starts to get warmer.
- There are often rain showers and sunshine.
- Flowers bloom and trees grow new leaves.
- Baby animals are often born in spring.
- The days become longer with more daylight.

## Summer




- Summer is usually the warmest season.
- There is often lots of sunshine.
- The days are long and bright.
- People wear lighter clothes in summer.
- Many people spend more time outside.
- Plants grow well because they have lots of sunlight.

## Autumn

- Autumn is the season between summer and winter.
- The weather becomes cooler, windier and wetter.
- Leaves change colour before falling from trees.
- Trees can become bare in autumn.
- The days begin to get shorter.
- There is less daylight than in summer.

## Winter

- Winter is usually the coldest season.
- The weather can be frosty, icy, snowy or rainy.
- People wear warm clothes to keep warm.
- Some animals hibernate during winter.
- The days are shorter and the nights are longer.
- There is less daylight in winter.
