Source	Where the river starts
Mouth	Where the river ends
River	A natural stream of water flowing to the sea.

- Many rivers start high up in hills or mountains.
- This is where its source is found.
- There are a few different types of river source.
- It can be a lake, a bog, rainfall or a spring.
- The flow of the water slows as a river twists and bends.

They are Winter, Spring, Summer and Autumn.

- Winter**- The coldest season.

- Summer**- the warmest season.
- Autumn**- the weather gets colder and leaves fall.
