I hope you have had a good Summer holiday with your children and families, and that they return ready and refreshed for an exciting Autumn Term at Wren's Nest.




Gold Woodland Trust Award. The photographs inside this newsletter are some taken from that

Contact details - time to update! (Green form) - Once again, we are updating the information record to ensure we have the most recent telephone numbers and contact details for you and your child. These details are essential in case we need to contact you urgently or contact a close relative if you are unavailable. Please only complete and return this form if your details have changed since last September, either by giving it via their class teacher or by hand into the main school office.

<u>Permission for local visits</u> (<u>Blue form</u>) - Each year we need to ask you to complete a permission form to enable your child to take part in activities in the local area outside the school gates. These activities are always planned and you will be informed before such activities take place. <u>Please complete this form and return it via your child to their class teacher</u>. We have many local area visits to look forward to and enjoy during this Autumn Term.

Parental Contribution to Enrichment Programme (Pale pink form) – Our Enrichment Programme will be continuing for the children here at Wren's Nest. This will include trips and visits to offsite venues, visitors and speakers into school, Enrichment Days, WOW days, our small group tuition programme, our Free Early Birds Breakfast club as well as a range of after-school clubs and activities for your children to take part in. This year, we are asking for a £20 monetary contribution per child to support us in allowing this wonderful and valuable programme to continue. As you can appreciate, sadly all costs across all sectors have increased. This year, school are providing £55,000 to fund the programme and your contribution will support us in trying to give your children as many enrichment opportunities as possible to support their learning. We really do value the contribution you are able to make on behalf of your child. Thank you for helping us do the best for your children's education.
