At Wren's Nest, we use Wow Days to launch a new unit of learning in an exciting and memorable way. A Wow Day takes place at the very start of a topic and is carefully planned to fully immerse the children in what they are about to learn.

During the day, children are introduced to key ideas, vocabulary and themes from the unit through engaging activities that spark curiosity and enthusiasm. These experiences help children make meaningful connections and build excitement for the learning journey ahead.

On some Wow Days, both children and staff dress up around a theme linked to the topic. This adds an extra layer of fun and imagination, helping children to feel involved and inspired from the very beginning. We have found that Wow Days have a very positive impact on children's engagement, confidence and enjoyment of learning.

Wow Moments at Wren's Nest

In every lesson across the wider curriculum, we also include Wow Moments. These are exciting and fundamental pieces of learning that capture children's attention and bring lessons to life. Wow Moments are carefully chosen to support the main learning objectives while creating a sense of surprise, wonder or excitement. They help children remember key information, ask questions and become deeply engaged in their learning.
